A huge "Thank You" from Peterborough Lions Club goes to everyone who took part in this year's quiz! Money is still coming in, but even so far we've raised a lot of money for good causes with your help. (Last year we raised well over £5000). Thanks of-course also to Lion John Cheetham and his team for creating yet another brainteaser; it's been my pleasure to take on the role of administrator this year.

The trickiest question this year turned out to be Q14: "Contrast between two things" (9 letters). As you'll see overleaf, the answer was "dichotomy" ("a division or contrast between two things that are or are represented as being opposed or entirely different", according to the Oxford English Dictionary). The most common wrong answer was "antipathy" (which the OED defines as "a deep-seated feeling of aversion").

The most commonly misspelled answers this year were both names: Q48 (Judi, not Judy) and Q65 (Denzel, not Denzil).

How did you do? Were you tripped up by one of those three questions? If you were then you were in good company – out of around 1100 quizzes returned for marking (from around 9000 sold), the prizes were drawn from just 38 completely correct answers, so it really is worth returning them if you think you've done well! (My own score was closer to 50% so well done to everyone who came close!)

We hope you enjoyed it however well you did, and that you'll be back again next year. Providing some light entertainment to keep those brain cells working in the run up to Christmas is of-course one of the reasons we do this every year, but the bigger reason is to support the good work that Lions do in the community. A big thank you comes from the users of our community minibus which enables a whole host of activities to take place around Peterborough, and from the hundreds who attend our annual Showtime, which is a rare night out for many of our elderly and disadvantaged neighbours.

As Lions, we are part of Lions Clubs International, the world's largest service organisation. We are all unpaid volunteers giving a little of our time back to our communities; every penny we make from selling quiz sheets and other activities goes to good use (all our admin costs are covered by club members). It genuinely does make it worthwhile when people come looking for the quiz every year, or come to talk to us about projects we've been involved with in the past or might be in the future.

If you do have a little spare time and would be interested in putting it to good use, then please drop us a line. If you're not local to us – this quiz goes far and wide – then we'll put you in contact with a local club if we can. Of-course volunteering is, rather obviously, voluntary, and if like most people you don't have the time free or are already involved with other organisations then please do continue to come and say hello when you see us shivering outside a supermarket. Even the little things such as "liking" and "following" us on Facebook help us to get our messages out there, and will let us remind you that you can buy our quiz sheets online via our website when the next one is released in a few months time.

2017 was Lion John Cheetham's last as quizmaster; very large shoes to fill but I'll do my very best. The best compliment that I could hope to receive at the end of 2018 would be that I haven't deviated from his high standards; Peterborough Lions Quiz is an institution that we hope to preserve for many years to come.
