Thank you to everyone who took part in our 2021/22 "It's About Time" quiz. Whilst 2021 certainly wasn't a normal year, it was an improvement on 2020, and we were able to get out a little more to distribute them to local shops and even sell them in person, so we sold a few more – and got a few more back to mark as thanks!

For the first time that I can remember, we have no ~~deliberate mistakes~~ errata to report. Normal service will, I imagine, resume soon enough! We also have relatively few alternate answers, leaving me with less to talk about here, but I'm sure I can still fill a page...

We had three pretty common wrong answers. Around a third of returned quizzes confused 1086's "Domesday" Book (Q79) with the end of times "Doomsday", a mistake I might honestly have made myself (and the reason this quiz is a team effort). Most people spotted that "Recorded the meeting" was past tense and correctly answered "Minuted", but we did have a significant minority offering "minutes" instead. And Chamberlain's "Peace for our time" is often misquoted using "in" or "of" (a subtle difference that the number of letters gives away if you don't miss them).

£8.91 was the price on our only notable alternate: Minimum Hourly Wage and Rate are equally acceptable.

How did you get on? Too easy or too hard? We had some lovely letters and comments – all feedback, even negative, is important to us. We've also already had several pre-orders for the next quiz, so it's a good job work is already underway on it – even if it isn't released until September! As always, this and other past issues are available on our website for fun/fundraising purposes to keep you occupied until then (and there's a couple of lockdown freebies there if you missed them).

We're still in the process of collecting money from the shops and pubs who supported our quiz this year but it looks like sales are up on last year – retailers being open makes a difference it seems! However we can say for sure that this is one of our most significant fundraisers for the year and cannot overstate our gratitude for all those who sold them for us, and of-course all those who parted with cash for them. This is also a significant fundraiser for many groups who sell these quizzes on a 50:50 basis – do get in touch if that might apply to you next time around (and also, of-course, if you'd be able to sell them for us in the future).

I have a bit of space left to plug Lions Clubs International: around 1.5m unpaid volunteers across pretty much every corner of the globe raising money and providing time for local welfare projects. Members fees cover our admin costs so every penny raised from things like quiz sheets gets used to support those activities, such as helping kids access the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, running a community minibus for use by other local groups, supporting abuse victims and the homeless, entertainment packs for hospital patients isolated from loved ones by the pandemic, as well as being able to respond to a myriad of small individual requests for help. When we take your money we take (Lions') pride in ensuring it is well spent, and if you have any time to offer we'd love to take that too – get in touch if you are interested in volunteering (even if not local, we can direct you to a closer club). In the meantime, please do come and say "hi" as things return to normal, and in the meantime, "liking" and "following" us on Facebook helps us reach more people.
