‘ALTERED IMAGES’

PARTIAL PICTURES, BUT WHO, WHAT OR WHERE ARE THEY?

A change from our usual format this time, and almost universally well received (one person indicated a general dislike for picture quizzes just proving you can't please everyone!). The change in format means that in most cases there was a definitive answer for each question and only a few alternate answers. It also means we got more 100% returns than usual – did you think it was too easy? Please do tell us!

One errata this year: the correct spelling of the Ukrainian President's surname (Q60) is Zelenskyy, and we'd only allowed for a single "y". Most people recognised Volodymyr anyway so it probably didn't affect the outcome of the quiz, but as always with errata, this question was excluded from marking.

So which ones did you find difficult? Q58 tripped many of you up – the Palace of Westminster is indeed the home of the Houses of Parliament, and we'd have accepted the latter as an alternative answer if it shared the same numbers of letters, but it's one letter short. Another common error was mistaking RMS Titanic (Q35) for HMS, or Mount Fuji (Q77) for Etna. Two versions of Windows shared a similar logo, but only XP fits the letter count (Q90), so we couldn't accept Windows 7.

Are you good with faces? Stan Laurel (Q25) caught a few out but the trickier one was Q88, for which, if you noticed, the quiz title was a second clue: Clare Grogan, also known as Kristine Kochanski in Red Dwarf, gained her a place in the quiz as lead singer of 80's band Altered Images.

As mentioned, there were a few alternates. We'll accept Union Jack or Flag (Q51), The Olympic Games or Rings (Q29). Our answer for Q78 was Guinness Draught, but we also accepted Company and Brewery variations. And for those of you who recognised the coin in Q65, we accepted Threepence, Thruppence and Thruppenny alternatives to Threepenny Piece.

Thank you to everyone who sent us their answers, and for the many notes and letters that came with them. We know that our quiz is a necessary part of Christmas for many of you so please do keep the letters and emails coming – all feedback, even negative, is important to us. We've also already had several pre-orders for the next quiz, sadly at its new higher price of £2 due to cost increases, so you'll be pleased to hear that work is already underway to come up with some new questions for you ready for release in September. As always, past issues are available on our website for fun/fundraising purposes to keep you occupied until then, alongside the opportunity to pre-order our 2023/24 offering.

We're still collecting money in, but already this has – again – been a great fundraiser for us, for which we are always in your debt. Thank you from all of us in the quiz team, from Peterborough Lions Club, and from all the individuals and causes we're able to support with these funds. As you'll probably know, club members fees cover all admin costs so every penny raised from things like quiz sheets gets used to support activities – for more information check out our website, or follow us on Facebook ("liking" and "following" us helps us reach more people). Just know that when we take your money we take (Lions') pride in ensuring it is well spent, and if you have any time to offer we'd love to take that too – get in touch if you are interested in volunteering (even if not local, we can direct you to a closer club).
