Finding a good quiz topic is always a challenge. Sometimes you spend hours on an idea only to realise it isn't working, forcing a fresh start. It's rare that the final topic resembles those early thoughts, and 2025 was no exception. When you need inspiration, nothing beats a hearty breakfast – and so it was that, over a meal at Jinja Express in Fletton, the theme for our 2025 quiz finally came into being.

We aim to make the quiz easy to start but harder to finish, yet the questions that stump people are rarely the ones we expect. Those that caught the most people out were Q40 (“If one of us were a ‘fun guy’” – many forgot this was a Lions quiz, hence “Lion’s Mane **Mushroom**”), Q33 (“We had to Squeeze this in” – the capitalisation was a clue to the Squeeze single “Black **Coffee** in Bed”), Q54 (“Movie score”, a sly reference to Rotten **Tomatoes** ratings), and Q63 (**Butternut** was the “Orange squash” we were looking for). One question (Q96, “Tofu ingredient”) was particularly hard to adjudicate, but in the end we couldn't accept common answers “soyabean” (which is actually two words, “soya bean”) or “beancurd” (another name for tofu, not an ingredient of it). Congratulations to everyone who did get these questions correct!

The team had several favourite questions; for me, it was Q94’s “So long, farewell, auf Wiedersehen, goodbye” while others loved Q31 (“Bee groomer”), Q77 (“Panto with a giant following”), and the delightful Q100 (“Geg”). All of these were overwhelmingly answered correctly (see overleaf if you're still stuck!).

Once again, we received several valid alternative answers we hadn't considered and added them to our list. For example, “**Cheating**” would indeed make the quiz easier (Q76), and **Seating** (Q52) is a great place to sit!

Marking hundreds of returned quizzes is a long task, but it's fantastic to have so many to process. We truly appreciate the many “thank you” notes that accompanied them. Thank you to everyone who bought quiz sheets this past year, and to those who sold them for us or in support of another great cause on a 50:50 basis. Now would be a great time to get in touch if you'd be interested in selling the 2026/27 quiz later this year.

Planning for 2026 is underway and will be available, as usual, from 1st September. Thank you for the pre-orders already received; that option is also live on our web store (pblions.uk/store) alongside any past quizzes you may have missed. We hope you enjoyed “All Day Breakfast” (all feedback is gratefully received) and hope to see you again this autumn.
